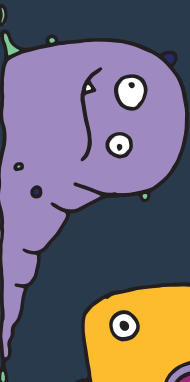

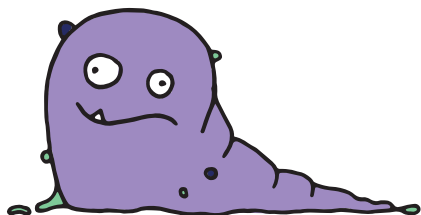


Thank you for choosing to have some **'monster fun'** to raise funds for Fred Bennett's 'Don't Look Down Fund' this Halloween.

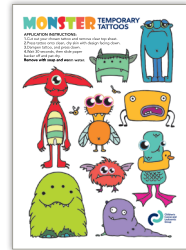

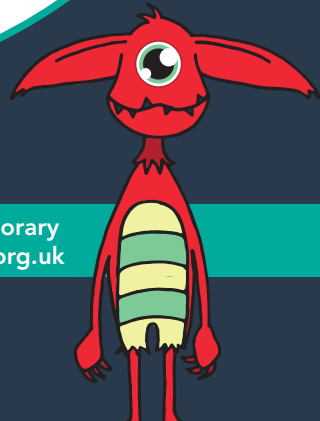

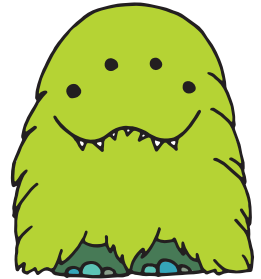


There are lots of fun ways you could raise money for Fred Bennett's 'Don't Look Down' Fund, here's some ideas to get you started.

HAVE A MONSTER...

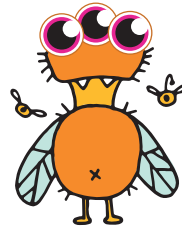
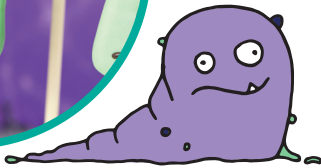
...DRESS DOWN DAY

A great way to raise money and awareness, encourage your friends, colleagues or school to get baking. **Raise extra funds with a monster themed cake-decorating competition!**



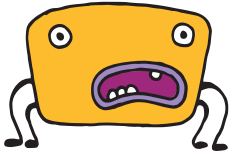
...MOVIE NIGHT

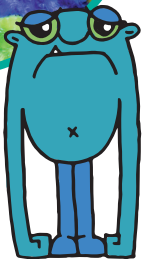
...PARTY

Fred Bennett's 'Don't Look Down' Fund is a special Named Fund at CCLG raising money for research into acute lymphoblastic leukaemia (ALL) in memory of 14-year-old Fred Bennett. Fred was 13 years old when in July 2019 he was diagnosed with ALL, a cancer of the blood.

Louise, Fred's mum says "We have set up the Don't Look Down Fund in the hope that more children will get the chance to live the life they deserve. We chose the name as to encompass Fred's fearless and risk-taking attitude as well as conveying how difficult the whole journey is."

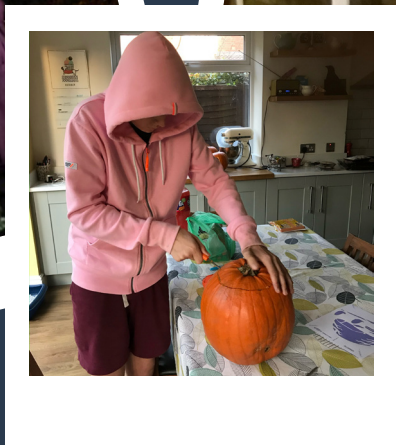
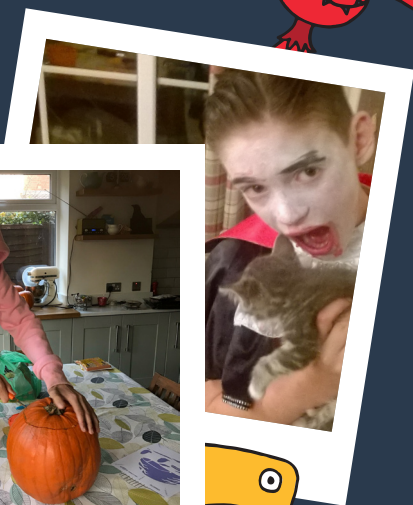

Paying in online

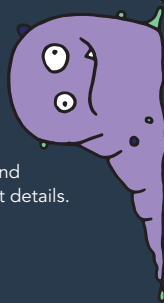
